

Frog, Mohji in One Piece, Shou Tucker in Fullmetal Alchemist, Han in Blue Gender, Hiro in Shin Chan, Ashe in Black Butler, Reever in D.Gray-man, Hector in Glass Fleet, Yuichi in Initial D, Akai in Oh Edo Rocket. Melt in The Tower of Druaga, Adashino in Mushishi, Eric Nishijima in Darker Than Black, Havel in Trinity Blood, Austria in Hetalia and many more. He has been a writer on Hetalia, Sgt. Frog, Baccano, Spice and Wolf and others. As a filmmaker Chuck has acted, produced, written or directed for Arbor Day - The Musical, The Troubadoors, The Fragility of Seconds, The Mechanical Grave, and Odd Man Out, among others. He began acting in Chicago at the Goodman Theater, the Court Theater, and the Steppenwolf Theater after graduating from DePaul University. He continues to work on stages in the Dallas/ Fort Worth area. Most recently he played Hugh Jameison in the movie Parkland, produced by Tom Hanks and starring Billy Bob Thornton and Paul Giamatti.

On the gaming side of the ledger, you can hear Patrick as Ragna in the BlazBlue franchise, Scorpion in the last few Mortal Kombat titles, Lucian, Kog'Maw, and Renekton in League of Legends, Fenrich in Disgaea 4, Chopin in Eternal Sonata, Dracula in various 2D incarnations of Castlevania, Cervantes in SoulCalibur V, Bob and Hugo in Street Fighter X Tekken, Arthas Menethil and Garrosh Hellscream in World of Warcraft, and a bevy of demonic horrors in Diablo 3. When can I get autographs?

During our scheduled autograph sessions. Please do not ask for autographs before or after panels. Guests are very busy at a convention and have other panels and events they need to attend.

Do autograph sessions cost anything?

Nope! The autograph sessions are open and free to all attendees and staff.

Sometimes guests have merchandise available for sale.

What can I have guests sign?

There is a limit of two autograph items per person. Have more things you'd like signed? Come back for the next autograph session for that guest.

Good autograph items

- » DVD cover of a show a person was involved with
- » The inside cover of a manga that person's character appears in
- » Kumoricon program guide (it has autograph space in the back)
- » An autograph book
- » Blank paper

Bad autograph items:

- » Bootlegged or unlicensed items
- » Items from shows they were not in
- » Items from shows you suspect they were in and credited under an alias
- » Body parts
- » Convention badges
- » Food
- » Trash

Can I take my picture with the guest?

To make sure we get through as many people as possible, we ask that guests don't pose during the autograph sessions. If you would like a photo taken, a Kumoricon staff member will be able to take pictures while the guest is signing for you.

What is Kumoricon's autograph policy? Autograph sessions run from 90 to

120 minutes (unless there's additional time and the guest agrees to it), it is important to keep the following in mind: » Each person is limited to two items to

- be signed per session.
- » A guest may decline to sign any item.
 » There is no guarantee guests will be able to make it through everyone.
- » Please have items ready to be signed when you approach.
- » If you would like a photo taken, please have your camera or phone out and ready when you approach the front of the line. A Kumoricon staff member will then be able to take pictures while the guest is signing for you.



How are guests selected?

Kumoricon asks that if you have a suggestion for a guest, please email guests@kumoricon.org, subject line "Guest Request". These suggestions (as well as suggestions from staff members) are reviewed by the members of the Relations Staff. The staff helps narrow the list down (based on popularity. availability, cost) and the Director of Relations begins to track down the potential guests on the list and offer invitations

Can I be a guest?

If you're someone who has done something of note in the anime or manga industry, drop us a line! Unfortunately, we receive many more people asking to be guests than we could possibly afford to have at the convention. Please do not be offended if we turn you down, even if you offer to come for free. We hope you understand that our Guest Relations staff has limited resources and can only handle so many guests. However, you are still welcome to attend the convention and can apply to host a panel if you wisl

Why do you get so many American dub voice actors as guests?

Well, there are quite a few reasons why conventions tend to get more American guests than Japanese/Asian guests. American guests are very popular within anime communities. They also have the added benefits of not needing a translator, being able to go into the city without an escort, and are a lot cheaper to fly in rather than flying in from Japan.

I'm friends with someone you may want as a quest. Should I invite them for you?

While we realize you probably have good intentions, but please do not invite guests on Kumoricon's behalf. Our Relations Department handles all of our guest and industry contacts to ensure we can continue to invite the guests and industry our attendees are interested in. This prevents any miscommunications which could hurt Kumoricon's chances of having a particular guest or industry epresentative attend in the future.

What days will the guests be at Kumoricon?

Unless we say otherwise, all of our guests will be at the convention for all four days. Guests will be scheduled for various panels and autograph sessions throughout the weekend

Can I give the guest a present?

Attendees are not allowed in the Art Show before opening or after closing, even if the doors are open. Artists may come in to set-up/check on their artwork.

No cameras of any sort are allowed in the Art Show, except for supervised press or staff. If you are found taking video or photos of artwork, your camera will be confiscated.

BIDDING

All art work will be displayed with an art tag listing the title, lot number, and the type of media, which is signed by the artist on the back. A bid sheet listing the lot number, minimum starting bid, and a "Buy it Now" price (each determined at the artist's discretion) will also be included.

Buy it Now - If the art work does not have any bids attendees can take the "Buy it Now" option and enter their badge number and the "Buy it Now" price. Take the bid sheet to the staff table to pay the "Buy it Now" price. Once purchased, you and a staff member will sign the art tag and the staff member will take down the piece.

Place a bid - An attendee can place a bid on an item by entering their bid and badge number on the bid sheet. All bids must be in whole dollar increments, and must be greater than the minimum bid price set by the artist.

Winning an item - The last bid must be completed by 6:00 PM on Sunday. There is a tiered pickup schedule on Monday the 1st.

Please write legibly, and use your full name so we can contact you, if necessary.

In the event of dispute over payment, the art tag will act as a receipt.

ART PICK UP

9:00 AM - 11:00 AM - Highest bidders can claim and purchase the item.

11:00 AM - 12:00 PM - If an art piece has not been claimed by the highest bidder, the second highest bidder can claim and purchase the item.

12:00 PM - 1:00 PM - Remaining art pieces will be priced at the "Buy it Now" price or the highest bid, whichever is lower. The first person to agree to this price can purchase the item.

If the bidder does not pick up the artwork, they will be noted in our database as a Delinquent Bidder, and may incur the fee of shipping the artist's artwork the following year when registering for Kumoricon.




CONVENTION MAP

Kumoricon is pleased to present two separate semi-formal dance events this year.

The Kumori Ball and Kumori Prom will be held on two separate days.

These are semi-formal events. To preserve the character of these dances, proper attire is required. If you are not properly attired, you will be turned away at the door. Below are some helpful guidelines, but if you have questions, please don't hesitate to ask us at kumoriconball@kumoricon.org. We are happy to advise you, so if you are unsure just ask.

For the Kumori Ball, this dress code will be especially strictly enforced in the interest of keeping the event as close to a classical style ball as possible.

FOOTWEAR

Comfortable shoes are required, so please choose something you will be able to dance in. For the Kumori Ball only, shoes must be closed-toe. For both events, sneakers must be clean looking and still in relatively good condition. Keep in mind you will be required to wear shoes the entire event so make sure your shoes are comfortable.

ATTIRE

Non-formal fabrics such as flannel, denim, and Mylar shall not be allowed. Recommended fabrics are cotton, silk and other light weight and breathable, flexible fabric as you will be moving around a lot. At least half of your body must be covered in fabric – avoid bare midriffs and bare chests as those are unacceptable. Formal/semi-formal attire from East Asian countries is acceptable.

Female attire: Semi-formal attire includes prom dresses, evening gowns, cocktail dresses, and dressy separates. Skirts should be no shorter than knee-length and at least an inch off the floor for ease of movement

Male attire: Minimum of a button down shirt and slacks are required.

Cosplay attire: Cosplay must meet the above set guidelines. Your cosplay does not need to be a specific character; generic cosplay will be accepted. A shinigami outfit is acceptable as it falls under traditional Japanese dress; generic street clothes are not. Military uniforms are accepted as formal wear.

Large props, wings, and weapons will not be allowed for the sake of safety requirements. If any part of your attire restricts your movement, you may be asked to remove it.

Whatever you decide to wear, it must be appropriate to wear in public and adhere to the minimum dress code standard as set forth in the Convention Policies. We will be sad to turn you away at the door, but we reserve the right to deny entry to anyone wearing inappropriate attire. There will not be a coat/bag check at the event, so please do not bring personal items with you. We will not be held responsible for any lost or stolen items at the event.



OLICIES

BADGES AND ID

ID is required to buy a membership or check in.

Don't forget it! You need ID no matter what.

Badge required: Your badge is your proof of membership. You must wear it in convention space.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

Under age 18? Parent permission form required and curfew applies. Under age 13? Parent must accompany you (separate paid membership required) and curfew applies.

Minor curfew: 12:00 midnight to 6:00 am throughout all convention space.

To attend an event marked 18+, you must have a hand stamp. ID will not be accepted at the door! Take your badge and ID to the Programming Booth to get your stamp (or Programming Office after hours). Some 18+ events are before curfew hours. No exceptions to curfew or 18+ restrictions!

FOR CROWDED EVENTS...

When an event on the schedule says "pass required", it means you need to pick up a pass from the Programming Booth earlier in the day. These passes are free, but usually run out quickly. Once all passholders in line have entered, we'll open the room to non-pass-holders if there's extra space.

30-minute line rule: Please don't line up more than 30 minutes ahead of any event.

NEED ASSISTANCE?

Disability assistance: Please ask a staff member at Registration or in the Operations Office for information on disability accommodations. Animals: ADA service animals are welcome at the convention. Otherwise, animals are not permitted.

Lost and found: Lose your badge, phone, or wallet? Find a fellow attendee's lost item? Please pay us a visit in the Operations Office. If we don't have your lost badge, Registration can reprint it for you, but there may be a fee.

Info booth: The info booth in the lobby of the Hilton can answer most

Harassment concerns? Flag down a nearby staff member, or visit the Operations Office to discuss or report an incident or concern.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Be polite with your camera and how you conduct your photography or video recording. Photography and video recording are generally permitted, except when:

- » The subject asks you not to or attempts to leave upon seeing the camera:
- » A reasonable person would know the subject would probably not want to be photographed under the circumstances;
- » A panelist or event asks you not to, or a sign prohibits it;
- » In theater rooms, or art in the Art Show or Artist Alley (except with prior artist permission)

HARASSMENT AND OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOR

We want Kumoricon to be a safe and comfortable place. Harassment and offensive behavior are prohibited. This includes:

- » Unwanted physical contact
- » Threats
- » Heckling or jeering, either to a person or at an event
- » Staying near another person who has asked you to leave
- » Repeatedly following another person
- » Any form of rude, offensive, or disruptive behavior

OTHER BANNED CONDUCT IN CONVENTION SPACE

- » Consumption of alcohol (unless presented at an official convention event), drugs (including marijuana), smoking (including e-cigarettes), or intoxication
- » Lewd conduct
- » Unsafe behavior, including real or play fighting
- » Selling or soliciting items or services
- » Distribution of flyers or literature

PROP AND WEAPON SAFETY

Banned items:

- » Real firearms or ammunition (no exception for concealed carry)
- » Functioning projectile weapons, devices, or toys, including items meant to be thrown
- » Firearms or projectile items that look like they could be functioning from 10 feet away, even if they are non-functioning or are replicas
- » Paddles (all varieties—including "yaoi" or "yuri" paddles)
- » Live steel (sharp enough to cut)
- » Potentially dangerous props which are not part of a bona fide
- » Props wide or long enough to inhibit traffic

Peace-bonding: Any item or prop that **could** be used as a weapon, could be dangerous, or **appears** to be dangerous (even if it's not), must be peace-bonded. Peace-bonding is an agreement to carry your prop safely, and requires signing an acknowledgement of the requirements of safe carry. A staff member will attach a peace-tie to your item which signals to all staff that your item has been reviewed. Where? Peace-bonding will be conducted near the registration area and in the Operations Office.

Examples of items requiring peace-bonding:

- » Toy sword made of foam
- » Replica sword made of dull steel
- » Replica firearm

Examples of items not requiring peace-bonding:

- » Purse
- » Bag
- » Teddy bear


Prop conduct:

- » Do not brandish or wave around prop weapons
- » Do not point prop firearms at anyone
- » Prop firearms must have a highly visible orange tip
- » Prop firearms and blades must always stay holstered, slung, or sheathed, except while posing for photos



Special exception for disabled projectile items: Projectile items or replica firearms are allowed **only** if they are, or have been made, permanently non-functional. "Permanently" means it is not possible to repair or restore the item to functionality. In most cases this means the item must be filled with glue and all moving parts rendered immobile

Purchased items: If you buy a prop in the Exhibits Hall or Artist Alley, remember to get it peace-bonded, if needed. Also, exhibitors occasionally sell a few things that you can't carry around the con at all, like live steel swords. If you buy one of these, you need to immediately take it off-site or to your hotel room.



COSPLAY, CLOTHING, AND COVERAGE

Costumes or outfits must cover...

For females: The groin, complete buttocks, and sides of the breasts. Private parts must be fully covered and not visible or simulated. **For males:** Equivalent of a shorts-style swimsuit. Private parts must be fully covered and not visible or simulated.

Masks or face coverings may not be worn in hotel lobbies. **Footwear** must be worn covering the bottom of the feet.

The following is not allowed in convention space:

- » Signage or clothing containing profanity, explicit or graphic language, slurs, insults, threats, solicitations, or room party advertisements
- » Costumes or props which are vulgar, obscene, graphic, or sexually themed
- » We may limit offensive or disruptive costumes, props, signs, or clothing in our sole discretion

POLICY VIOLATIONS

Any violation of these policies or illegal action may be handled by a warning, temporary convention suspension, permanent membership revocation, or longer ban, in our sole discretion.

Allowable activity at the convention is at our sole discretion. If an authorized staff member tells you to stop doing something, remove an item, or leave an area, then it has the weight of these policies, even if it's not printed in these policies.

THE FINE PRINT...

Consent to official

photography: Any photographs or videos of attendees taken by Kumoricon staff in an official capacity may be used or published by Kumoricon without further consent of the attendees being recorded.

Liability: Kumoricon, its personnel, and its affiliates are not responsible for any damage, theft, injury, or loss. Attendees of the convention are responsible for their own actions as individuals as well as for any resulting repercussions. Staff are on hand for assistance in most situations. However, any civil or medical emergencies that may occur must be handled directly by the appropriate authorities.

Changes: Policies may be changed without notice. kumoricon.org/policies will always contain the latest version, and printed copies will be given upon check-in to the convention.

KUMORICON TRIVIA

- "Kumori" means "cloudy" in Japanese, making Kumoricon the "cloudy convention."
- In 2005 approximately 150 attendees violated Kumoricon's 30 minute lineup policy. Kumoricon staff formed the violators into a conga line, and danced them around the Lloyd Center Doubletree, putting them at the end of the line.
- Most of Kumoricon's content is submitted by and run by our attendees!
- It's traditional for the Kumoricon mascot to hold an umbrella, however there is no rule in the mascot contest saying that entries must include an umbrella. There is, however, a rule that mascots must be themed to Kumoricon.
- The official Kumoricon color is blue
- Kumoricon only had 22 staff in 2003.
 12 years later we have over 400!
- 100% of Kumoricon staff are volunteers!


