Director of Publicity announced that applications will be opening soon for Forum Moderators. Still hiring for a Press Coordinator and Photography Coordinator to improve our presence on youtube and make use of our existing photos. We will hopefully have new T-shirts by Sakura-Con. Contact Richoux with any ideas for merchandise.

Facilities Liaison reported on her contact with the Hotel about improving 2010 elevator and load-in logistics. She also hiring for an Executive Assistant and Runners. She is blanketing the town soliciting contract proposals. The March meeting will be in Eugene at EWEB. Staff room designations need to be sent in as soon as possible to get moved to the Staff Block and changed to the staff rate.

Director of Operations reported 500 current registered; all printed, waiting on letterhead, and then will be all caught up. Still hiring for many staff positions, plus a few manager positions. SEGC now has a mailing list, please send any suggestions

Secretary reported that 52 staff forms have been received, though not all have been ratified. Membership for 2009 will be expiring in the near future; a reminder will be sent with the exact date.
