Director of Operations reported that last month's information about registration was a little high. It is now about 450. The registration team is pretty solid, but yojimbo is accepting applications.

Directory of Relations reported that Harmony Gold will be returning this year, so there will be panels with give-aways and prize support. Artists Alley contract is being update to provide restrictions instead of requiring insurance policies that are out of reach for most artists. Graphic artists and partner coordinators are being sought. We're running a room at GameStorm, which will be fun.

Secretary reported that 52 staff forms have been received, though not all have been ratified. Membership for 2009 will be expiring; a reminder will be sent with the exact date. The Open Positions page shows the positions that are currently available for sign up, with links for further inquiry.
