Kumoricon / Altonimbus Entertainment Regular Meeting of the Membership on May 20, 2023, 1:00pm Online

Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 1:11pm by Robert Trotter.

At the initial quorum count, the meeting continued once 20 members signed in as present, thus meeting quorum. In total during the meeting, 32 members signed in as present out of 612 total, with 20 needed to reach quorum.

Bunny also reported:

 - o 64 small press applications

- o Jury slated to finish mid-June, but will likely be into July due to high volume
- Exhibitor Area ~65% full from 2022 pre-registration, currently have 50 applications to process, will likely be a lengthy waitlist
- Everyone is encouraged to report any AI art violators to us at-con we're hoping to catch all of them, but we need eyes!
- Bunny went on vacation for a couple weeks for the first time and is back working now. If you worked with Leon or Julie on it while Bunny was away don't worry, you're still being taken care of. But if you were waiting for something from her, it's a great time to check in. We are rehiring folks still and processing staff for all our teams. Right now is mostly getting caught up, helping other departments with projects, finishing up contracts for the future, and lots of meetings for the rest of the month to make sure everything is squared away for the best experience possible for everyone
