 - If you did not receive a ballot, please check your spam folder, and please email election.support@kumoricon.org if you have further questions.
 - You do not need to attend this meeting to vote.
 - Because all members have five days to vote, there is no proxy voting.
 - You cannot change your vote once submitted.
 - In order to reduce the chances of needing a runoff vote, voting will be conducted using approval voting, as specified in our recent bylaws amendment. In approval voting, members vote for as many candidates as the member approves of, with the winner being the candidate who receives the most votes, as long as it is a majority of votes cast. There will also be a "no confidence" option.

Hi.

Since my last email was omitted from the meeting minutes last week and was not mentioned this week, I am resending it. I never received any contact about why it was omitted or even that it was, just complete silence.

I am very disappointed by the decision to abandon the masking requirement from last year. Especially after so many high level staff were pledging to do better this year, and use the previous year's policy as the basis of this year's. Many people planned on coming because this was the only con they felt safe coming to and now many of them are unable to come. It's not just attendees, but also guests have expressed concerns on the discord about how they will keep themselves and their families safe while attending now:

So as I mentioned before I still mask up because my kid is high risk.

As a guest of honor this does put me in an uncomfortable spot because I wouldn't be comfy taking photos with/being close with people who aren't masked.

So it kinda puts me into a situation of like "Wow, Falinxie refused to take a photo with me because I wasn't wearing a mask. they weren't required"

This kind of this is absolutely unacceptable given that people who now cannot attend because of kumo's backtracking on the mask requirements can't even get refunded for their tickets, putting a greater financial burden on a population that is already suffering from the terrible health system here.

This is all exacerbated by the hr debacle that is ongoing. As has been pointed out that (https://www.kumoricon.org/staff-harassment-policy):

We (as managers and directors) must deal quickly and fairly with allegations of harassment or discrimination within our departments, whether or not there has been a written or formal complaint

This would indicate that managers and directors should be at least helping deal with the backlog of HR complaints.

My trust in Kumo's executive team has been shattered by the poor handling of health and safety, complaints, and lack of response to the community.
