Kumoricon / Altonimbus Entertainment Regular Meeting of the Membership on May 3, 2025, 1:00 pm Via Discord and Twitch

Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 1:03 pm by Robert Trotter, Chair.

At the initial quorum count, the meeting continued once 20 members signed in as present, thus meeting quorum. In total during the meeting, 33 members signed in as present out of 698 total, with 20 needed to reach quorum.

Rober Trotter, Chair, presented slides [lightly copy-edited]:

- Accessibility Awareness ADA Compliance vs Accessibility
 - ADA: A legal code that defines the MINIMUM standards of accessibility in the United States.
 - Accessibility: Design for use by disabled people
 - The legal definition of ADA compliance often falls short of truly making a space, design, etc. accessible.
 - The ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) is a legal code first enacted nationwide in the US in 1990. While it has received several updates since then, ADA code often lags behind true accessibility. Many spaces, such as convention sites, are ADA compliant but they are not necessarily accessible. Accessibility comes from an ongoing dialogue with disabled people who use accommodations to make sure that the accommodations are fulfilling their needs. It is the goal of an accommodation to allow a disabled person to enjoy a space, such as a convention, to the same extent as someone without disabilities.

Treasurer


Robert Trotter, Chair, on behalf of Jeremy Cook, Treasurer, presented slides [lightly copy-edited]:


Outreach

Devin Hunter, Lead, Outreach, presented slides [lightly copy-edited]:

- The Outreach team did a great job at Sakura-Con, yet the event fell short on all metrics (conversations, reg sales, merch sales). Many regular attendees are hesitating to register due to lack of funds or uncertainty around the future.
- There's a huge amount of goodwill for Kumoricon from attendees! People love our event!
- A big thank you to all the Kumo staff who dropped by the booth to say hi. It's a nice break from asking people if they have heard of Kumoricon.

 The [above] chart shows the number of "outreach conversations" that have occurred at events so far in comparison to our predictions at the start of the year. An "Outreach Conversation" is one where we have determined if the person knows about Kumoricon and assessed their commitment to attend Kumo this year.



- The [above] chart shows the accumulated event profit so far in comparison to our predictions. Profit is registration and merch income minus expenses to attend a specific event.
- Our conversation counts have a positive correlation to registrations and merch sales. The more
 conversations we have, the more we sell. Unfortunately, we are below our projected conversation
 counts, so it is understandable that we are also below our profit projections.
- We've only completed five events so far this year, so there is still a lot of time left to talk to new people and secure registrations from experienced attendees.
- The next set of events are:
 - Chibi Chibi Con on May 10 at Evergreen College in Olympia, WA.
 - Japan Fair [from] July 12 to 13 at Meydenbauer Center in Bellevue, WA. This is the first time we are going to this event!
 - o Portland Pride [from] July 19 to 20 at Tom McCall Waterfront Park in Portland, OR.
 - We also have a last minute event, Furlandia! [It] is happening [from] May 23 to 25 in Portland, OR. This is the local anthropomorphic arts convention. It's the first time we have been to this type of event and are excited to see what it's all about. If you are interested, we are quickly putting together a team.
