## STAFF PARENT PERMISSION AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM

You agree that Altonimbus Entertainment staff, organizers, employees, and/or agents have no responsibility whatsoever to monitor or supervise the minor at any time during Kumoricon 2019 or at other locations, and agree not to hold Altonimbus Entertainment, its Board of Directors, organizers, employees, and/or agents responsible for any wrongdoing, claims, demands, or liability;

In the unfortunate event of any damages caused by your minor child at any time during his/her attendance at Kumoricon 2019, or at other locations while performing staff duties, you accept financial responsibility and agree to fully indemnify and hold harmless Altonimbus Entertainment for those damages.
