Kumoricon / Altonimbus Entertainment General Meeting of the Membership on August 23, 2020, 1:00pm Online

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:07pm by Brian Mathews.

At the initial quorum count, the meeting continued once 28 members signed in as present, having not yet met quorum. In total during the meeting, 32 members signed in as present out of 259 total, with 30 needed to reach quorum. Quorum was met at 1:26pm.

Chair

Operations

Ben Riker, Director of Operations, reported:

- Checklist to submit a panel:
 - Read application (Intro, Things to note, Panel rules, FAQ)
 - Decide to conduct a live panel or pre-recorded panel
 - Note: Panel application submissions due 11:59pm, September 14, 2020.
 - Note: Pre-recorded panel (final version) due 11:59pm, October 1, 2020
 - Create a 1:00-1:30min video summary of your panel idea
 - Fill out the application form
 - Submit your application form along with your 1:00-1:30min video
- To be a panelist: (open to anyone—you don't need to be staff)
 - A device that can connect to Zoom (desktop, laptop, phone, or tablet)

- A camera that connects to that device
 - If you plan to use a phone, make sure to use something to hold the device (like a tripod).
- Headphones that connects to your device
 - This is to prevent echo
- o [Bonus] A quality microphone
- o Reliable internet connection
- An idea that you want to share
- A plan on how to share that idea
- What do you need to staff a panel:
- Stream Operator—behind the scenes, running Open Broadcaster Software, working with the production team.
 - Computer with Nvidia GPU
 - Dual monitors
 - One screen set at 1920x1080
 - Fast internet upload speed
 - 10Mbps
 - Audio headset
- Panel Moderator—host and moderator, working with panelist, running Zoom, and checking chat.
 - Computer that you can install software on
 - Audio headset
 - Reliable internet
 - Being comfortable with participating with live content.

Samantha Rushford, Director of Publicity, presented slides [lightly copy-edited]:

- We are primarily waiting on finalized shipping cost information and we can get our online merchandise store open.
- Finishing the public Discord server got held up by other projects needing our team's attention, but we are still working on it and hope to release soon.
- Merchandise:
 - We are going to have 3 different styles of ita bags. They feature a Ghost Neko cut-out on one side with a clear plastic pocket so that you can showcase your pins or keychains on the other. The bags come in white, blue, and black.
- Staffing needs:
